The HA Quality Mark is a recognised and valued award which provides a framework for success whether you are looking to gain the acknowledgement you deserve or whether you are looking to improve your history provision.

A Framework for Success

Effective teaching and learning: This quality is concerned with ensuring effective learning through appropriate and motivating teaching that engages pupils consistently throughout the school.

Leadership in history: This quality is concerned with ensuring that systems and structures are in place and used effectively to ensure that history enjoys a high status, reputation and profile in the school and beyond.

Curriculum: This quality is concerned with the coherence, logic and appropriateness of the curriculum in the context of the school.

Achievement: This quality is concerned with ensuring pupils achieve well and that their progress in the subject is appropriate to their ages and circumstances.

Enrichment: This quality is concerned with ensuring that the school enriches teaching and learning in history through other subjects and resources/programmes beyond the history classroom.
